• Kellyx advised the Board that we would not be considering the Grading Permit Exemption for Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District, they have tabled the request.

8. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

8.1 NRCS Staffing Update:

- Jim H advised that regarding Jim K's move to Marina, he and Daniel Mountjoy, Area Conservationist, had attempted to shift Jim K's duty station to Santa Cruz. Unfortunately, due to State restrictions, this shift could not take place. A compromise was reached and Jim K will spend two (2) days in Santa Cruz, two (2) days in Half Moon Bay, and one (1) day in the field.
- 8.2 Executive Director Year End Report:
 - Kellyx gave a Powerpoint presentation of the RCD's year in review.
 - We collaborated with new partners on new projects.

- We reinvented resurrected projects.
- We completed projects.
- She pointed out that in spite of the state funding freeze; resulting in layoffs, furloughs, and a decline in revenue, the RCD had persevered. We became scrappy and maintained our hold in the community.
- TJ suggested we put the year in review on our website, and possibly the county website (Rich Gordon's).

8.3 Briefing on Ponds Program:

- Kellyx and Jim gave a brief overview of the program.
- They are looking to Alameda as an example of a good program.
- It is not a high cost project to do.
- It is beneficial to producers and a good publicity project for the RCD.
- Project would create habitat and increase row crops.
- Storing water could add to water budgets for producers.
- Monitoring property for ascetics is also important to producers; many have been in the family for generations.
- TJ asked what are the costs to repair the ponds?
- Kellyx advised that "Construction" costs only could be 15-50K, this does not include engineering or project manager.
- Based on fiscal needs one suggestion was that we cost share with the Farm Bureau for access to a GIS internet site, therefore cutting the cost in half.
