

#### 5.2 Agricultural Water Quality Alliance Strategic Plan – Presented by Marti Johnson

- This is the 4<sup>th</sup> Action Plan involving AQWA partners and coalitions of many other agencies.
- Tim commented that the partners that put together most of the action plan were non-agency partners.
- The original plan and the significant amendment will be cycled thru on a monthly basis.
- Marti passed out a document delineating the major areas of focus.
- AQWA now has a "WIKI" web page where people can collaborate change content, and comment, etc.
- Marti coordinates 6 RCD's Upper Salinas/Las Tablas, Monterey. San Benito, Loma Prieta, Santa Cruz, and San Mateo
- Area meeting will be October 29, 2008 in King City, hosted by Monterey RCD.

#### 5.3 Lessons Learned – RCD Updates

- Kellyx gave a presentation of projects completed and some of the lessons the RCD has learned, some of these included:
  - o Projects and permits are not always in sync
  - o Participating landowners don't always agree
  - o RCD is developing new tools and templates
  - o People want to participate in actual projects
  - o RCD is getting better at coordinating stakeholders
  - o RCD is developing better partnerships and MOU's
- Ron commented that the Bear Gulch project was one of the most important projects the RCD has done and he was very impressed.
- Tim asked if the RCD has started thinking about a theme for the RCD in relation to projects the RCD is undertaking.

#### 5.4 Upcoming dates, Projects, and Potential Funding

- CARCD annual meeting November 19-22, in Riverside. Kellyx will be attending, however, since it affects Board date Rich suggested moving Board meeting to November 13.
- November 4<sup>th</sup> the Pilarcitos Watershed Plan will be released.
- November 6<sup>th (?)</sup> grand convergence of meetings with Rich Gordon Blue Circle, PRC meeting and Pilarcitos Release.
- October 20th first Watershed Discovery Workshop for fall.
- There are three potential internships available to the RCD
  - o Student interested in watersheds
  - o Gerry Davis a SFSU professor interested in Pilarcitos.
  - Berkeley students in a Public Policy Program interested in the ecosystem market.
     Jonathan Winston, an economist, has a theory of how to create a market for ecosystems.
  - o October 29, 2008 Central Coast RCD meeting.
- Final report for Whale Tail was submitted on September 30, 2008.

#### 5.5 RCD Office Space

• Kellyx gave a field trip tour of office space at the RCD.

- Rich has enlisted Bob Mitten, a realtor, from Pescadero. He has agreed to do an exhaustive search starting in Princeton. He and Bob will do a 1<sup>st</sup> round, then review with TJ re fiscal feasibility.
- Ron asked if it is possible for the RCD to build or own their own building.
- Rich said that the RCD is in a crisis mode right now and needs to find space immediately.

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#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2008-3**

# DESIGNATING THE AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT A GRANT PROPOSAL TO WHALE TAIL GRANTS PROGRAM FOR WATERSHED DISCOVERY WORKSHOP

Whereas the San Mateo County Resource Conservation District is a Special District organized under Division 9 of the California Public Resources Code with an original petition granted on July 1, 1939; and

Whereas the San Mateo County Resource Conservation District is defined in Section 3501 of the Government Code as a public agency; and

Whereas the California Coastal Commission's Whale Tail grants support programs that teach California's children and the general public to value and take action to improve the health of the state's marine and coastal environments; and

Whereas consideration for funding requires a resolution from the applicant's governing body containing the authorizations listed below;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Mateo County Resource Conservation District Board of Directors hereby authorizes Kellyx Nelson, Executive Director, to submit a grant proposal to the Whale Tail program for the Watershed Discovery Workshop and enter into a contract with the California Coastal Commission if the grant is awarded.
