Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors November 13, 2018 4:30 pm – 6:30 pm Location: RCD Office

1 <u>Call to Order</u>

Meeting was called to order at 4:31 p.m.

4 <u>Public Comment</u>

- There was discussion about the poor air quality in San Mateo County as a result of the Camp Fire.
- Reynolds commented on the RCD's increased visibility in Pescadero. Nelson said landowners had generously allowed the RCD on their property for surveying work.

2 <u>Approval Agenda</u>

- Nelson asked to pull item 5.1 because no one bid on this project. She explained that the contractor that was expected to bid wasn't in compliance at the time. She further noted that it had been challenging to find the required types of contractors, who meet state labor compliance requirements, as this falls into a category of public works projects like constructing the Bay Bridge.
- Glauthier asked Nelson what the RCD's plan was if no contractors bid. Nelson responded that the RCD has worked with a contractor in the past who had accidently let his compliance expire; she expected he would bid in the future. Staff are also incentivizing contractors that are in compliance, by explaining how many more projects are coming down the pipe.
- Nelson stated that the RCD will go out to bid again soon even if work doesn't start until 2019.
